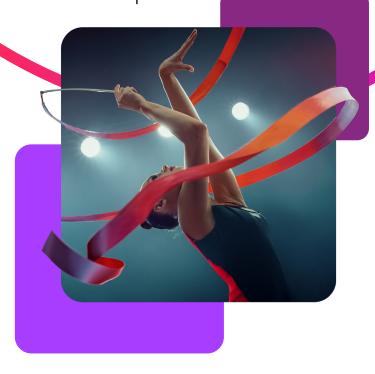

With 190 employees to manage, British Gymnastics recognised they would need an HR and payroll solution that focused on employee experience.
